Please make sure to remember the following information:

The online form will consist of two sections: the Parent/Guardian section and the Student section. Use this as a guide to help you gather the necessary information and complete the form in a timely and efficient manner. The deadline for submission is **December 31, 2025**, for the school year 2026-2027. Merit Scholarships will be awarded by mid-February and will be reflected on the re-enrollment contract.
