

La Pietra Merit Scholarship Award Guidelines for 2024-2025

Annually, La Pietra Merit Scholarship recipients and their families must apply for or renew their scholarship awards for the upcoming school year. The following are expectations for qualifying to receive the merit scholarship for the upcoming school year.

Overall Expectations - Scholarship Recipients and their families are expected to:

- Abide by and support the guidelines and expectations outlined in the current school year
 Parent and Student Handbook.
- Be positive, contributing members of the school's community, serving as role models for the La Pietra 'ohana and the community.
- Be cooperative and respectful in their manners, attitude, and communication (both verbal and written) to our school and the community.
- Be supportive of decisions made within the school community.

Student expectations – Student Life | Academics | Community

- Be a contributing member to student life by participating consistently in at least one extra-curricular activity such as student club, student council, student ambassador programs, Peer Leadership, school athletics, community service, etc.
- Maintain a 3.3 GPA or higher. A 3.3 GPA places you on the Honor Roll list.
- Participate in class discussions and as a member of the learning community in an enriching, positive manner.
- Volunteers at La Pietra sponsored special events.
- Continually demonstrate qualities of excellence and be exemplary role models within our school community and in the community.

This includes denial of the merit scholarship award if a student and/or family member does not meet the above-stated expectations.
